Use phrases like "You've shown you don't need more practice" or "You need more practice" instead of words like "qualify" or "eligible" when referring to extension work. Encourage high-ability students to take on challenges. Because they're often used to getting good grades, gifted students may be risk averse.

Six Strategies for Challenging Gifted Learners

Specifically, NAGC recommends that schools, school systems, and other education providers: • Employ appropriate identification protocols and programming models that cultivate potential in order to identify more gifted students from historically underrepresented groups.

A Definition of Giftedness that Guides Best Practice

Devise appropriate simulation activities To develop an appreciation for their high-level sensitivity that may manifest itself in humor, artistic endeavors, and intensified emotional experiences 1. Encourage positive and expressive outlets for sensitivity, such as tutoring, volunteer work, art, music, and drama 2.
