The following provides summaries and examples of all of the headings in APA, from your title, which is a first-level heading, to fifth-level headings. Your title should be presented as a first-level heading. It is centered, in bold font, and all major words should be capitalized. When all major words are capitalized, this is called Title Case.

Headings and subheadings are required to help organize and provide structure to MLA papers and essays. However, MLA does not exactly set rules for formatting MLA headings and subheadings. It just has to be consistent with the general formatting guidelines of the MLA style.

MLA Headings and Subheadings - Scientific Editing

Most APA style papers written by students are not experimental; the organization of headings and subheadings within the main body of the paper is therefore particularly important. In certain cases, the author might use additional major sections, such as a literature review, to introduce their own material.

Subheadings are used for divisions of the various chapters or titled sections of the manuscript. Subheadings must be used in the same order, levels cannot be skipped (for example, a first-level subheading may not be followed immediately by a third-level subheading), and must be used consistently throughout the manuscript.
