The Ford Ranger's gear shifter can often be in the way. If you need to work on the transaxle, or some of the manual transmission's components, the shifter will have to be removed. As a DIY mechanic, you should always be careful and exercise caution whenever working on transmission issues. But removing the shifter is not as complicated as other transmission jobs, and all you will need are some basic tools to do the job.

How To Remove a Ford Ranger Shifter | It Still Runs

Remove the camshaft gear using Camshaft Gear Puller T82T-6256-A. Remove the key, camshaft thrust plate (6269) and camshaft sprocket spacer (6265). Remove the camshaft (6250). Install the camshaft, camshaft sprocket and camshaft thrust plate as an assembly, making sure the timing marks are in alignment.

Install the cam gear, aligning the two dots. Remember that the 1932-1948 gears are cut one way, while the 1949-1953 gears are cut the other way. Do not mix and try to match. Step 3: The cam gear retaining bolts were saved because they are shouldered, but a new locking plate, available from various sources, is definitely a good idea. Step 4:

These genuine Ford gears were produced both with and without the aluminum hub center shown above. The fabric and phenolic gears having the aluminum hub centers often fail at the interface of the gear to the hub, loosening up and producing a knocking noise when running. In the extreme case, the fabric gear can separate from the metal hub.

Undo the pinch bolt and carefully withdraw the distributor. If the distributor is tight, insert a screwdriver blade between the open ends of the clamp plate and prise them slightly apart. As you withdraw the distributor, the rotor arm sometimes shifts slightly through the movement of the driving gear.

However, actually sliding the pitman arm off of the steering gear output shaft is sometimes rather challenging. According to the ford service manuals, simply place the appropriate pitman arm puller on the pitman arm, tighten the pressing bolt, and the arm will pop right off.
